	<p>Ian Harrison updated members on the progress with the acquisition of the various capital equipment for the Newark on Sea.</p> <p>Ian Harrison reported that we will use external contractors to install this year, with a view to observing and learning from the exercise, with the intent to undertake the install in-house in future years.</p> <p>Questions were asked about the sand and what would be done with it at the end of the event, which Ian clarified.</p>
