TC51/24/25 Town Mayor's Announcements

The Town Mayor said she had enjoyed the role and would be sad to leave.

TC52/24/25 Town Clerk's Announcements

Over 80 invitations had been issued for the VE Beacon Light switch-on.

Further invitations have been issued for the Mayor Making event.

The Town Clerk clarified the situation regarding political stance during council meetings. He recognised that training in the sector prescribes a non-partisan approach; however, legislation does not support this.

The Town Clerk apologised to Cllr L Geary in relation to errors in the last FGP Minutes, which provided an incorrect impression of one aspect of a vote.

TC53/24/25 Leader of the Council's Announcements

The Leader had sent her Apologies.

TC54/24/25 Questions from Town Councillors

Cllr L Goff raised an issue in relation to the lack of a blue plaque for Emily Blagg. Emily Blagg is buried in Newark Cemetery and is not recognised.

Cllr B Corrigan supported the proposal and offer to support Cllr L Goff in his pursuit of this matter.

Cllr L Goff clarified that he wanted signage within the Cemetery to show the location of the grave.

TC55/24/25 Questions from Members of the Public

A response was proposed from the Chair of FGP which outlined the criteria for the Sherwood Avenue Playpark; this would explain that other parks include swings and that swinging motion is provided by some of the equipment at Sherwood Avenue.

TC56/24/25 Cemetery Development

The Town Clerk presented the responses from the Public Consultation regarding the future of Cemetery provision in Newark

It was proposed by Cllr D Ledger and seconded by Cllr B Corrigan that this report be **NOTED** in preparation for a confidential presentation from the Town Clerk.

A vote was held, and this was **AGREED**.

TC57/24/25 Exclusion of the Press and Public

The Town Clerk gave a presentation in relation to the future of burial provision in Newark.

The proposal was to consider the Crematorium first and then the creation of a new Cemetery.

Main points raised were:

- Greatest revenue comes from direct cremations
- Concerns raised with the possibility of partnerships with private companies, despite a reduction in financial and operational risk
- The current situation is at the limit of BTC capacity and knowledge and external consultants would be required.
- Alternative burial provision was considered.

Cllr D Ledger proposed that this item should be deferred to the Cemetery Development Working Group, along with options and costings.

This was seconded by Cllr B Corrigan, a vote was held and it was **AGREED**.
